## *Environmental Education Comes Home for Students During COVID-19 Pandemic*

we reinforce the importance of environment preservation in children from early age in order to make them conscious of the decisions they make. They will also correct their elders when they see them doing things that are harmful for the environment

**The following activities were planned to create environment preservation awareness among students at home**

- planting a small organic garden
- **Cleanliness drives**
- **.Embedding environmental preservation in the curriculum** –children start learning about environment preservation from an early age.For example If children are being taught about water as an EVS (environmental studies) topic then teachers apprise the children about water scarcity and ask them to creatively think of ways to conserve water by closing the tap after use, water harvesting, innovate means to keep water bodies clean and so on.
- **.Environment preservation posters created digitally** –Students were given activities like prepare digital posters, artwork, etc. to make it a part of their subconscious learning.

- **Adopt a plant programme:** Students were given project to adopt one plant at home and take pledge to provide complete care to it with the help of a gardener or parents and others.
- **Values to have empathy for living creatures** – to inculcate empathy in children. and to understand that all living creatures need to be looked after, We imparted this value through stories and role play where children become animals, plants or insects. The teachers ask them how they would feel if their homes and habitats are destroyed.
- **Best Out of Waste –Students are asked to reuse things to make new useful things.**
